

# Water Conservation Board Game

## What You'll Need

1 game board


1 six-sided die

Marker tokens, one per person **(these can be any small object, or borrow them from another board game set)**

About 50 water tokens **(Use marbles, beads, dried beans or anything you have to represent water)**

## Game Rules

- Reach the end with the least amount of water.
- Roll the die and move that number of spaces on the board.
- Take or give back water tokens based on where you land.
- Whoever has the least amount of water when they reach the end wins!



# FINISH!

Go **enjoy** your favorite CA lake.



You wash the dishes with running water.



TAKE 4.

You use greywater to water your plants.



Put 3 back.



Big Bear Lake. **Free Pass**

You don't use **compost** or **mulch** to reduce water runoff and evaporation. Take 2.



# How much **water** do you use?

You **TIME**



your showers. Every minute equals 2 gallons of water. **Put 3 back.**

**TAKE 3**



You run your **DISHWASHER** when it's not full.



You keep a **CA FRIENDLY LAWN** that is drought tolerant. **Put 3 back.**

Take 5.



You have an **old toilet** that uses 7 gallons of water per flush.

You leave the faucet running while brushing your teeth. **Take 1.**



**Put 2 back**



You load up your **washer** to its capacity.

You put off repairing a **leaky faucet.**

90 gallons or more a day are leaked.




**TAKE 4**

**Free Pass**



You hose down your driveway instead of **sweeping.** A garden hose emits **6 to 24 gallons** per minute.

You own a **POOL** but don't cover it.

**YOU TAKE A 30-minute SHOWER.**

You turn off the water while **BRUSHING** your teeth.

**PUT 1 BACK.**
